Here are the draft tasting notes for the Kent beers. These will be updated as we get more information and clarification about the beers that we will be serving at the beer festival.

Beer from Kent		
A.D.H-Me Angels & Demons, Capel-le-Ferne	5.2%	An American Pale Ale containing a plethora of flavours, with a massive dry hop hit coupled together with multi-layered grain flavours.
Black Taxi to the Moon Angels & Demons, Capel-le-Ferne	5.4%	Impeccably balanced Smoked London Porter. The full bodied bitter chocolate and underlining sweetness adding to the complexity of this ebony vixen.
Goldilocks is Dead Angels & Demons, Capel-le-Ferne	5.3%	Sponsored by The Chambers, Folkestone Incredibly silky Oatmeal pale ale holds an absolute explosion of flavour, married with huge hoppy aroma, all nestled within glorious depth of character and super smooth mouth feel.
Black Prince Rum Porter Bexley, Erith	5%	A dark rich porter with a roasted, vanilla aroma and a sweet chocolate, coffee flavour.
Howbury Mosaic IPA Bexley, Erith	5%	A hoppy American IPA, with pleasant citrus hoppiness, and a well-balanced malt flavour. Golden in colour with citrus and fruity aromas.
Howbury Oat Stout Bexley, Erith	5%	A lovely oat stout, rich, dark with a slight sweet finish.
Calico Jack Breakwater, Dover	6.2%	Sponsored by the Three Mariners, Hythe. A spiced rum stout. Spiced herbs and rum added to the boil alongside vanilla beans and oak woodchips. An explosion of complex flavours.
Tropical Thunder Breakwater, Dover	6.3%	Sponsored by the Mash Tun, Dover. A hazy, double dry hopped IPA. Low bitterness with juicy flavours from Mosaic, Ekuanot and Citra hops coming through
White Cliffs Wonder Breakwater, Dover	5%	A ginger wheat beer. Crisp, refreshing and light.
Triple Hop IPA Brew-Buddies, Swanley	6%	A New England IPA has a pale malt body with a touch of wheat and Vienna and is jammed full of juicy American hops.
Winter Porter Brew-Buddies, Swanley	5.2%	A smooth well balanced porter with caramel, chocolate, coffee and rich malt flavours. Hopped with the finest East Kent Goldings.
IPA Canterbury Brewers, Canterbury	5.6%	A take on their West coast IPA, brewed with English Pale malt and lots of American hops.
Itzamna Imperial Porter Canterbury Brewers, Canterbury	9.6%	Sponsored by Nick Bailey A smooth, strong imperial porter that has a deep chocolate sweetness, given balance by the fresh vanilla and the deep, roasty malts.
Cavedweller Caveman, Swanscombe	5.8%	A rich porter with a full body and balanced hop bitterness, with chocolate and coffee notes and dark berry flavours.
Strong Ale Caveman, Swanscombe	5%	
Gold Star Goachers, Maidstone	5.1%	Sponsored by Tom (Thomas & Partners Estate Agents) A true draught pale ale made with floor-malted low-colour Maris Otter malted barley and hopped with the finest East Kent aroma hops.

Old 1066 Ale Goachers, Maidstone	6.7%	Sponsored by the King's Head, Kingsdown A fruity rich barley wine that has been produced in small quantities every winter since 1983.
Good Lord Goody, Herne Bay	5%	A rich, medium-full bodied porter with smooth roasted coffee tinge and silky bitter finish.
A.P.A. Hopdaemon, Sittingbourne	5%	Sponsored by The Elephant, Faversham An American-style Pale Ale.
Green Daemon Hopdaemon, Sittingbourne	5%	Sponsored by The Elephant, Faversham A golden Bavarian Helles lager-style beer with luscious tropical fruit aromas and a crisp, clean finish.
Bullion Bomb Hop Fuzz, Hythe	5%	A Special American IPA. Sweet and light with a hop kick from the rare Kent Bullion hop.
Twelfth Night Barley Wine Kent, West Malling	7.4%	A luxurious, aged barley wine with a rich fruity body. A blend of dark malts and English hops give a complex layered flavour
White Cliffs Hot Chocolate Special Kent, West Malling	5.5%	A luxurious balance of chilli and chocolate to complement a rich and complex Porter.
Ninth Life IPA Mad Cat, Faversham	5.9%	A high-gravity IPA. Cascade and Columbus hops dominate this strong ale with full-bodied pale malts to balance the hoppiness.
Powder Burn Musket, Maidstone	5%	A Kentish Porter that is dark and mysterious yet explodes with flavour.
Nelson's Blood Nelson, Chatham	6%	A strong malty ale with mellow roast tones, slightly nutty & fruity with a warm aftertaste.
Dark Side of the Moo Old Dairy, Tenterden	7%	A full-bodied Imperial Porter with a bright fruity character and punchy aroma balanced with spicy chocolate flavours and smooth bitterness.
Dark Snow Old Dairy, Tenterden	6.5%	A limited edition, combining Snow Top and Dark Side of the Moo, to create the perfect 'winter warmer' for those long cold nights
Secrets We Share Pig & Porter, Tun. Wells	5.2%	The result of 3 strong pale ale recipes, this one was the winner by a healthy margin. Brewed with Pale and Munich malts and Mandarina Bavaria, Cascade and German Comet hops.
Slow Black Pig & Porter, Tun. Wells	5.1%	A rich, complex oatmeal stout with smooth coffee & chocolate notes and a hint of berry fruit.
DogBolter Ramsgate, Broadstairs	5.6%	A dark porter with a satisfying, rich, malty body full of roasty, chocolatey flavours, all balanced by a deep and lasting hop bitterness.
Gadds' No. 3 Ramsgate, Broadstairs	5%	A fresh pale ale, simply brewed, with pale malt and Goldings hops from Humphrey's farm, just down the road. It's hoppy, clean and bitter.
Uberhop Ramsgate, Broadstairs	5.2%	Deeply hoppy traditional lagerale brewed with flashy continental malts and bucketfuls of grassy, spicy Noble hops.
Black IPA Ripple Steam, Sutton	5.8%	A balanced blend of smoked Munich chocolate and pale ale malts, giving a smooth chocolate body with dry, bitter end notes.
American Pale Romney Marsh, New Romney	5%	Burnt orange in colour. Vienna malt gives this stronger ale an orange hue and biscuity taste, combining with a strong fruit punch from all-American hops.
American Pale Tonbridge, Tonbridge	5%	Classic, full-bodied American-style pale ale with a refreshing citrus finish.
Grim Reaper. Wantsum, St Nicholas-at-Wade	5.2%	A Red Rye IPA. It has a rich base with a hoppy aroma and citrus flavours from the Amarillo hop.
Ravening Wolf. Wanstum, St Nicholas- at-Wade	5.9%	Sponsored by the Fox, Temple Ewell An amber-coloured New Zealand pale ale, toasted biscuit & rye malt flavours support a pine & lemon hop crispness and a hint of vanilla.
Audit Ale Westerham, Westerham	6.2%	A tawny, brown strong ale with the aroma of port, raisins and molasses, and a complex fruit-smooth warming flavour.

Viceroy IPA Westerham, Westerham	5%	Sponsored by the Sir Norman Wisdom, Deal A true English IPA with a citrus, nutty, hoppy taste. Brewed with National Trust Pale Ale Malt and Scotney Castle Hops. Gluten-free.
Kentish Reserve Whitstable, Maidstone	5%	Reddish-amber-coloured premium bitter, malty notes with flavours of peaches & plums, ending on a note of rich ruby port.

Gold Angel 1648 Brewing, E. Sussex	5%	Bright gold, full-bodied flavour with gentle citrus hop flavour.
Old Colony 8 Sail Brewery, Lincs.	5.3%	An American style Pale Ale hopped with a combination of English Pilgrim and American hops.
Victorian Porter 8 Sail Brewery, Lincs.	5%	A classic Victorian Porter brewed using Pale, Brown and Black Malts, Fuggles for bitterness and Goldings for aroma and flavour.
Old Dalby Belvoir, Leics.	5.1%	A rich smooth ruby red strong ale mingled with a variety of complex flavours thanks to an unusual blend of classic hops.
Vanilla Stout Binghams, Berks.	5%	Infused with vanilla pods that compliment the dark malts to create a smooth-drinking, deliciously dark stout.
Thomas Sykes Burton Bridge, Staffs.	10%	A straw coloured old ale with rich, fruity spirited tastes - warming & dangerously drinkable.
Lambeth Walk By the Horns, London	5.1%	Black London Porter. Velvety, rich & chock full of flavour with notes of coffee bean, cocoa, toasted hazlenuts & hint of dark berries.
Santa's Sledgehammer Cairngorm, Aviemore	5.6%	A strong bronze coloured ale with a traditional hop bitterness & a warming aftertaste.
Revelation Dark Star, W. Sussex	5.7%	A blend of Centennial, Liberty, Cascade, and Citra aroma hops by the sack full - then dry hopped during conditioning using the 'Hoptimizer'.
Resolution Downlands, W. Sussex	5%	Sponsored by The Lanes, Dover A session double IPA with a punchy tropical, citrus and fruity hop loveliness.
Russian Rouble Flipside, Notts.	7.3%	A strong dark Russian Imperial Stout with rich chocolate and malt flavours. Brewed using traditional English hops.
Laid Back Stout Framework, Leics.	5.7%	A roasted, smoky, multi-grain stout using Cascade and Centennial hops. Suitable for vegans.
Nip Grainstore, Leics.	7.3%	A true barley wine that's smooth and warming. The well-balanced blend of flavours, sweetness and bitterness compliment each other.
Rutland Beast Grainstore, Leics.	5.3%	A strong mild ale with complex flavours of chocolate/coffee & those of raisins & autumn fruits.
Duck Under Green Duck, W. Mids.	5%	Rye IPA with a strong malt backbone and an intense hop flavour delivering a well-balanced drink with a bitter citrus finish.
1833 IPA Hart Family, Northants.	6.6%	Authentic IPA brewed to an 1830's English recipe.
Duke IPA Highland, Orkney	5.2%	The six different hops in this beer gives it an assertive bitterness.
Notting Hill Ruby Rye Moncada, London	5.2%	Sweetish ruby red-coloured beer with a full, fruity aroma, a creamy mouth-feel & a little roast throughout.
Son of Impy Moncada, London	6.5%	Vanilla custard stout.
Allelic Drift Mordue, Tyne & Wear	5%	A pale, golden-coloured ale with floral, pine & citrus notes and a clean bitterness. A Panda Frog Project.
WT20 Mordue, Tyne & Wear	6%	Complex, tasty bitter with plenty of malt & hops, long satisfying bitter finish. A stronger version of Workie Ticket.
Saviour Navigation, Notts	5.5%	Sponsored by Narrowboat Annie Wright. American style IPA, brewed with lager malts, well balanced with full American hop flavours.
Nimbus Blonde Orkney	5%	Crystal clear straw gold. East Kent Goldings & Styrian Goldings hops, Maris Otter & wheat malts.
Poacher's Ale Parish, Leics.	6%	Deep ruby-red coloured, full-bodied, malty beer.
Cascadia Phipps, Northants	5%	New World IPA brewed from a combination of Phipps IPA English grist and a selection of Pacific North Western hop varieties.
Gold Star Phipps, Northants	5.2%	A strong pale ale with the colour and drinking quality of the IPA but with a subtle punch of an export strength ale.
Wynters Ale PJ's, Stirling	5%	A dark amber malty ale.

American Pale Ale Portobello, London	5%	A fruity clean & refreshing beer with citrusy notes of orange and pink grapefruit. Absolutely packed full of flavour.
York Chocolate Stout Rudgate, Yorks.	5%	A deep rich and satisfying premium stout with complex balanced flavours and a warm subtle chocolate finish.
Dark Ruby Mild Sarah Hughes, W. Mids.	6%	A dark ruby strong ale with a good balance of fruit & hops, leading to a pleasant, lingering hops & malt finish.
Disco Balls Shiny, Derbys.	5.3%	Sponsored by SpecSavers Opticians, Folkestone. A big hitting, hop loaded, English IPA.

Kent Ciders

Note: We have made every effort to ensure that the cider/perry being served at this festival meets CAMRA's definition of a real cider/perry.

Yowler Medium Kent Cider Co.	5.5%	A dark and fruity, medium apple cider created from 100% pressed Kentish apples.
Pear Kent Cider Co.	6.0%	A medium, still pear cider produced from Doyenne Du Comice pears.
Toffee Apple Kent Cider Co.	5.5%	Perfect combination of crisp apple with sweet caramel and demerara sugar gives this traditional cider a contemporary twist.
Hop Kent Cider Co.	5.5%	Produced using local East Kent Golding Hops. The bittering of the hop adds an interesting complexity to this dry-on the finish cider.
Firespice Ginger Cider Kentish Pip	4.0%	Ginger-infused cider, gently spiced with a little hint of chilli heat.
Wild Summer Elderflower Cider. Kentish Pip	4.0%	Hand picked fresh elderflowers infused to create an enticing, zingy Wild Summer cider.
Pear & Russet Kentish Pip	6.5%	A cider-perry combination blending Egremont Russet apples and Conference pears. It has a beautiful pear aroma and a clean finish.
Apple Pie Turner's	4.0%	Our winter warmer, flavoured with spices and sweetened with fresh apple juice.
Gold Turner's	4.0%	A low ABV cloudy apple cider, sweetened with the fresh juice of Cheerfull Gold apples.
Bitter Sweet Wise Owl	6%	Crisp, fruity cider made from a blend of bittersweet & dessert Kentish apples, Rich in colour with a lovely aroma & depth of flavor.
